Tom Snelling is a paediatric infectious diseases physician, and Director of the Wesfarmers Centre of Vaccines and Infectious Diseases at the Telethon Kids Institute. He is also an Honorary Fellow at the Menzies School of Health Research, and Adjunct Associate Professor with the School of Public Health at Curtin University. He leads the Implementation Research Team which is focused on the optimal use of preventive strategies to reduce the burden of infectious diseases in children. They do this through a range of observational and interventional studies, including adaptive trials. He is deeply committed to policy implementation as a permanent member of Australia's Pharmaceutical Benefits Advisory Committee (PBAC) and previously as a permanent member of its Economics Sub Committee (ESC).
